From AI to Industry 5.0: Students Join DERHE Training Courses

As part of the DERHE project, a series of short courses for students are being organized in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro, to enhance digital knowledge and practical skills beyond the regular curriculum. The courses combine online learning with hands-on training in Multifunctional Learning Centers (MLCs), covering topics such as Lean Management, AI, Cybersecurity, Project Management, Industry 5.0, Energy Efficiency, and other emerging digital and industrial trends. The initiative aims to equip students with future-oriented competencies while collecting feedback to support the modernization of study programmes and strengthen the alignment of higher education with labour market and digital transformation needs.

The training activities will be implemented with the support of the Chambers of Commerce participating in the project, which will facilitate engagement with companies and identify training needs, as well as with the academic support and supervision of experts from KU Leuven and the University of Ljubljana.

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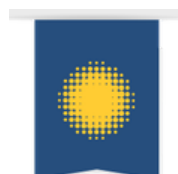
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
